ORDER:

In the Government Order 1st read above, the Government direct that a fee of Rs.1000/- (Rupees One Thousand only) be collected for embalming dead bodies. In the Government Order 2nd read above, orders were issued for establishment of Free Hearse Service in all the Government Medical Institutions on Public Private Partnership mode similar to 108 Ambulance Services.

- 2. In the letter 3rd read above, the Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health Systems Project, has stated that the Free Hearse Service has transported around 46,814 dead bodies during the last year and this is provided free of cost. Out of these, 46,814 cases, nearly 50% of cases are medico legal in nature. He has also stated that at present, cases beyond 300 kilometers are transported through railways. As per the railways protocol, Post Mortem cases should be embalmed before transportation by rail. Around 5% of the cases required embalming and as per the Government order, a sum of Rs.1000/- per case has to be remitted to Government account before embalmment.
- 3. The Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health Systems Project has also stated that the Free Hearse Service program is fully funded by the State Government and hence, he has proposed to amend the Government order by waiving the embalming charge for Free Hearse Service programme. He has requested that necessary orders in the waiver.

4. The Government after careful consideration of the proposal of the Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health Systems Project, and waive the embalming charges for the Free Hearse Services Programme.
