### ORDER:

In the Government order first read above, the Government of Tamil Nadu has launched a new scheme "Innuyir Kappom – Nammai Kaakkum 48" and accordingly orders have been issued to reduce the death rates due to road traffic accidents and save the lives of Road Traffic Accident victims within Tamil Nadu during the first 48 hours of accident which is the golden period for saving lives.

2. In the Government order second read above, orders have been issued for Guidelines, Process flow, Logo of Nammai Kaakkum 48 Scheme. Further, orders have been issued to implement the "Innuyir Kappom – Nammai Kaakkum 48" scheme under assurance mode for the policy period 2022-2024 and 2024-2025 in the Government orders third and fourth read above, respectively.

3. In the Government order fifth read above, under this scheme, 101 designated treatment modalities/ procedures for damage control measures costing up to Rs.2.00 lakh per individual is being extended on a cashless basis on assurance mode to all Road Traffic Accident victims, irrespective of whether they possess a Chief Minister's Comprehensive Health Insurance Scheme (CMCHIS) card or not. The services are provided through 723 empanelled Government & Private Hospitals.

4. The Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health Systems Project has furnished the performance of NAMMAI KAKKUM 48 (NK48) Scheme for 13th Policy period (11.01.2024 to 10.01.2025) and total number of Pre-auth submitted is 1,16,614

amounting to Rs.1,02,65,15,067/-. During the inauguration of the scheme, the Government decided to implement the scheme under Assurance Mode by the Chief Minister's Comprehensive Health Insurance Scheme insurer United India Insurance Company Limited wherein Tamil Nadu Health Systems Project will release premium to United India Insurance Company Limited along with 10% of administrative cost according to the claims raised.

5. The High level Committee has approved to implement this scheme under assurance mode for the next policy period (11.01.2025 to 10.01.2027).

6. The Government, after careful examination, have decided to extend the policy period to implement the "Innuyir Kappom – Nammai Kaakkum-48" scheme under assurance mode from 11.01.2025 to 10.01.2027.
