ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above, the Government have issued orders for establishment of Project Management Unit with staff strength of 50 number of various posts. In the Government order second, third and fourth read above, orders were issued regarding first, second and third year activities towards the recurring and non-recurring expenditure for Project Management Unit of Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program respectively.

2. The Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program in her letter read above, has proposed to sanction the Project Management Unit cost for the fourth year in the Budget Estimate of 2022-23 as follows:

3. The Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program has stated that the State Empowered Committee had approved the above proposal and requested the Government to issue necessary orders in this regard.

4. After careful consideration of the proposal of the Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program, the Government have decided to accept the same and accordingly issue the following orders:-

- (i) Sanction is accorded for a sum of Rs.6,73,32,174/- (Six Crores Seventy three Lakhs thirty two thousand one hundred and seventy four only) consisting of a non-recurring expenditure of Rs.12,00,000/- and a recurring expenditure of Rs.6,61,32,174/- for the Project Management Unit of Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program during the year 2022 – 2023.
- (ii) The Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program is permitted to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned above.

5. The expenditure is sanctioned in para 4 (i) above shall be debited to the following head of account:-
