ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above, the recurring cost of Rs.1.17 Crore towards the establishment of Trauma Registry at 27 Trauma Care Centres Registry was sanctioned. As part of Registry component 2 posts of Trauma Registry Assistant to each center also sanctioned. Subsequently in the Government Order second read above, the recurring cost of Rs.1.06 Crore was sanctioned.

- 2. In continuation of the above, the Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program in the letter read above has sent a proposal towards the recurring cost for the establishment of Trauma Registry in the above said 27 Trauma Centres (as mentioned in Annexure II) for the year 4 (2022-2023) as detailed in annexure-I to this order.
- 3. The Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program has stated that the above proposal has been approved by the State Empowered Committee and hence requested the Government to issue the orders in this regard.

- 4. The Government after careful consideration of the proposal of the Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program have decided to accept the same and accordingly issue the following orders:-
 - Sanction is accorded for a sum of Rs.1,07,63,928/- (Rupees One Crore Seven Lakh Sixty Three Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty Eight Only) towards the salary of Trauma Registry Assistants including EPF in 27 Trauma Care Centers as mentioned in Annexure-II
 - Sanction is accorded for a sum of Rs.15,78,000/- (Rupees Fifteen lakhs Seventy Eight thousand Only) towards the Establishment of IT platform of Trauma Registry and Operational cost of Trauma Registry software.

iii. The Director of Medical Education is authorized to draw and disburse the

amount sanctioned at para 4(i) above.

- iv. The Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program is authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned at para 4(ii) above.
- v. A separate account to be maintained exclusively for Tamil Nadu Health Systems Reforms Project funds in the Directorate and facilities involved which should be operated by joint signatory.
- 5. The expenditure sanction is para 4 (i) above shall be debited to the following head of account:-
 - "2210 Medical and Public Health 01 Urban Health Services Allopathy -110 Hospitals and Dispensaries - Externally Aided Project - PE - Tamil Nadu Health Systems Reforms Project - Administrated by the Director of Medical Education - 309 Grants in Aid - 03 Grants for specific schemes
