ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above, the Government have accorded sanction for the establishment of Emergency Management Services in Tamil Nadu under the Public Private Partnership Scheme. A Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with the Emergency Management Research Institute (EMRI), Hyderabad was signed on 06.05.2008 and the services were put into operation on 15.09.2008. 108 – Ambulance Service is operational in this State to provide emergency ambulance service to transport the victim to the appropriate hospital. To provide the service under PPP mode, centralized system of operation was adopted.

2. In Government Order second read above, the GVK Emergency Management Research Institute (EMRI) has been permitted to extend their services for further period of five years from 05.05.2013 and an Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) was signed between Government of Tamil Nadu and GVK EMRI on 31.07.2013. In Government Order third read above, the Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) was extended for a further period of 6 months till 04.11.2018. And in Government Order fourth read above, the GVK EMRI has been permitted to extend their services for further period of 3 months with effect from 05.11.2018 with the same service provider with the existing terms and condition in the Memorandum of Understanding (MoU).

3. The Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health Systems Project has requested the Government to permit her to extend the service for five years from 05.02.2019.

4. The Government have examined the proposal carefully and accordingly, the Government direct that the Emergency Ambulance Services implemented vide Government Order first read above, be extended for a period of one year with effect from 05.02.2019 with the same service provider with the existing terms and conditions in the Memorandum of Understanding (MoU).

5. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O.No.59143/Finance(Sal)/2018, dated: 10.12.2018.


