ORDER:

In the Government order first and second read above, orders were issued regarding the upgradation and strengthening of trauma care centers and provision of funds for the salary of certain posts sanctioned therein.

2. In continuation on the above, the Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program in her letter read above, has requested to issue the necessary orders on her proposal towards the recurring Cost of year 4 (2022-2023) for the Upgradation and Strengthening of Trauma Care Centres and furnished the budget provision involved in this activity as given below:-

- 3. The Government after careful consideration on the above and decided to accept the same and accordingly issue the following orders:-
 - (i) Sanction is accorded for a sum of Rs.15,00,11,440/- (Rupees Fifteen Crore Eleven Thousand Four Hundred and Forty Only) towards the upgradation and strengthening of Trauma Care Centres through the Directorate of Medical Education.
 - (ii) Sanction is accorded for a sum of Rs.83,23,440/- (Rupees Eighty Three Lakh Twenty Three Thousand Four Hundred and Forty Only) towards the upgradation and strengthening of Trauma Care Centres through the Directorate of Medical and Rural Health Services.
 - (iii) The Director of Medical Education is authorized to draw and disburse the sanctioned amount at para 3(i) above.
 - (iv) The Director of Medical and Rural Health Services is authorized to draw and disburse the sanctioned amount at para 3(ii) above.
 - (v) A separate account to be maintained exclusively for Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program funds in both the Directorates and facilities involved which should be operated by joint signatory.
- 4. The expenditure sanctioned in para 3(i) above shall be debited to the following heads of account:-

The Director of Medical Education is also requested to include the expenditure of Rs.17,66,000/- while sending the budget proposals for Final Modified Appropriation 2022-2023 and also send draft explanatory notes for specific inclusion in the Supplementary Estimates 2022-2023 to Government in Finance (Budget-I/Health-II) Department at an appropriate time without fail.
