ORDER:

The Hon'ble Minister for Health and Family Welfare has made the following announcement (Announcement No.47) on the floor of the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly during the Demand No.19:-

"புற்றுநோயைத் துல்லியமாக கண்டறிந்து சிகிச்சை வழங்க சேலம் அரசு மோகன் குமாரமங்கலம் மருத்துவக் கல்லூரி மருத்துவமனையில் ரூபாய்.4.00 கோடி மதிப்பீட்டில் சி.டி. சிமுலேட்டர் கருவி நிறுவப்படும்."

2. Based on the above announcement, the Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program has sent a proposal wherein it has stated that the Government Mohan Kumaramangalam Medical College Hospital is one of the important Tertiary Care Centre which caters to the basic and advanced Medical & Surgical needs of the people in and around Salem District. The Hospital consists of 1642 beds. The institute caters to about 3196 patients per day as Outpatient and 1669 patients as inpatient admissions per day. The institution provides major specialty services including cancer care to poor patients from Salem and nearby districts.

3. The Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program has also stated that the hospital currently provides radiotherapy services to patients diagnosed with cancer with one functional telecobalt machine which caters to on average of 45 patients per month. In addition, a Medical Linear Accelerator (LINAC) and HDR Brachytherapy have been sanctioned, for which the initiatives towards installation are on process. The institution is currently staffed with 2 Radiation Oncologists who provide OPD services to more than 1200 patients on average. Hence, it is proposed for procurement of one CT Simulator for Strengthening of cancer care in Government Mohan Kumaramangalam Medical College Hospital, Salem at a cost of Rs.4.00 crores through Tamil Nadu Medical Services Corporation Limited during the year 2024-2025.

4. The Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program has additionally furnished the General performance, Oncology Department performance, Chief Minister's comprehensive Health Insurance Scheme performance and also justified to take up the activity.

5. The State Empowered Committee has approved the above proposal.

6. The Government, after careful examination, have decided to accept the proposal of the Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program and accordingly issue orders on the following:-

- i) Sanction is accorded for a sum of Rs.4,00,00,000/- (Rupees Four Crore Only) towards procurement of one CT Simulator for strengthening of Cancer care in Government Mohan Kumaramangalam Medical College Hospital, Salem through Tamil Nadu Medical Services Corporation Limited.
- ii) The Director of Medical Education and Research is authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in para 6(i) above.

7. The expenditure sanctioned in para 6(i) above shall be debited to the following head of account:-

4210 - Capital Outlay on Medical and Public Health – 01
Urban Health Services – 200 other Health Schemes -

8. Necessary additional funds of Rs.4,00,00,000/- will be provided in Revised Estimate / Final Modified Appropriation 2024-2025. Pending provision of such funds, the Director of Medical Education and Research is authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in para 6(i) above. However, this expenditure shall be brought to the notice of the Legislature by **Specific Inclusion** in the Supplementary Estimates 2024-2025. The Director of Medical Education and Research is also directed to include this expenditure while sending the budget proposals for Revised Estimate / Final Modified Appropriation 2024-2025 and also send draft explanatory notes for inclusion of this expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates 2024-2025 to Government in Finance (BG-I/Health- II) Department at an appropriate time without fail.
