#### **ORDER:**

The Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program has stated that the Modern Contraception Usage at Reproductive age (15-49 years) are as follows:

As per World Bank, increased usage of modern contraceptive methods needs to be done. Modern methods include male and female sterilization, injectables, IUDs/ PPIUCDs, contraceptive pills, implants, female and male condoms, diaphragm, foam/jelly, the standard days method, the lactational amenorrhoea method and emergency contraception.

2. Based on the NFHS 4 result, the following districts have been identified as priority districts:

- 6. The Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program has requested the orders of the Government in this regard.
- 7. The Government after careful consideration of the proposal of the Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program have decided to accept the same and accordingly issue the following orders:-
- i. Sanction is accorded for a sum of recurring expenditure of Rs. 12,00,000/- (Rupees Twelve Lakh only) towards Printing of Family Planning Card in 10 priority districts (listed in table at para 2 above) to the Directorate of Family Welfare.
- ii. The Director of Family Welfare is permitted to draw and utilize the amount as sanctioned in para 7 (i) above. A separate account to be maintained exclusively for Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program funds in Directorates, Districts and Facilities (till beneficiary level if needed) involved, which should be operated by Joint Signatory.
- iii. The expenditure sanctioned in para 7(i) above shall be debited under the following head of account:-
