ORDER:

In the letter read above, the Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program has stated that the Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program (TNHSRP) is implemented by the Government of Tamil Nadu with financial support from the World Bank and focusses on improving the health status of people belonging to the lower socio-economic strata. New approaches to address and curb the burden posed by the Non-Communicable Diseases (NCD) and therefore reducing the deaths and disabilities due to NCDs forms the core of this Project. The high burden of NCDs, pose a serious danger to the welfare of the individual, the household and the nation as well. Thus, the prevention and management of NCDs is of prime importance as these diseases lower the quality of life, impair economic growth and place a heavy, rising demand on families. The amount claimable from World Bank on achieving the expected control rates as follows:

The Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program has further given the justification to the strengthening of the Government Stanley Medical College Hospital and to ease the economic burden to the NCD/Diabetes patient, she has requested to start exclusive Advanced Master Health Checkup program with the certain packages for Whole Body Master Health Check up and Women Special Master Health Check up Unit as annexed to this order.

3. The Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program has furnished the rough cost estimate of the purchase of requirements for strengthening the Stanley Medical College Hospital works out to Rs.1.65 Crore as follows:-

4. The Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health System Reforms Program has stated that the above proposal had been approved in the State Empowered Committee and hence requested the Government to issue the orders in this regard.

5. The Government after careful consideration of the proposal of the Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program have decided to accept the same and accordingly issue the following orders:-

- (i) Sanction is accorded for a sum of Rs.1,65,00,000/- (Rupees One Crore Sixty Five lakh only) towards the strengthening the Government Stanley Medical College Hospital, Chennai.
- (ii) The Director of Medical Education is authorize to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned above for the procurement of the required equipment through Tamil Nadu Medical Services Corporation Ltd.
- (iii) The Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health System Reforms Program is permitted to carry out the proposed activities in coordination with the Director of Medical Education.
- (iv) The Dean, Stanley Medical College is permitted to commence Master Health Check-Up and to fix the package cost of Master Health Check-Up and Women Special Master Health Check-up Unit (as annexed to this order) and to utilize Human resources and infrastructure preparedness from available funds in Stanley Medical College Hospital.

6. The expenditure sanctioned in para 5 (i) above shall be debited to the following head of account:-

2210 Medical and Public Health - 01 Urban Health Services – Allopathy - 110 Hospitals and Dispensaries - Externally Aided Projects - PE Tamil Nadu Health System Reforms Project - Administrated by the Director of Medical Education - 319 Machinery and Equipment - 01 Purchase.

7. Necessary additional funds of Rs.1.65 Crore will be provided in RE/FMA 2022-2023, Pending provision of such funds in RE/FMA 2022-2023, the Director of Medical Education is authorized to draw and disburse the above sanctioned amount. However, this expenditure shall be brought to the notice of the Legislature by

Specific Inclusion in the Supplementary Estimates 2022-2023. The Director of Medical Education is also requested to include this expenditure while sending the budget proposals for RE/FMA 2022-2023 and also send draft explanatory notes for inclusion of this expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates 2022-2023 to Government in Finance (Budget-I/Health-II) Department at an appropriate time without fail.
