ORDER:

The Hon'ble Minister for Health and Family Welfare has made the following Announcement in the floor of the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly during the Demand No.19.

Announcement No.27:-

"தருமபுரி மாவட்டம் -அருர் மருத்துவமனைக்கு உலக வங்கி திட்டத்தின் கீழ் ரூபாய் 2.30 கோடி மதிப்பீட்டில் CT Scan மற்றும் C-arm உடன் எலும்பு முறிவு அறுவை சிகிச்சை மேசை (Fracture Table) வழங்கப்படும்".

2. Based on the above announcement, the Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program has sent a proposal read above along with the justification, vital statistics and general performance of the Government Hospital, Harur, Dharmapuri District and requested to provide whole body Multi Slice CT-Scan and High End Image intensifier C-Arm with C-Arm Compatible Orthopaedic Fracture Table with attachments to that hospital.

3. The Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program has worked out the cost involved in the above activity and furnished as follows:-

4. The Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program has stated that the above proposal has been approved in the District Health Assembly / State Health Assembly / State Empowered Committee and has requested the Government to issue necessary orders in this regard.

5. The Government after careful consideration of the proposal of the Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program have decided to accept the same and accordingly issue the following orders:-

- (i) Sanction is accorded for a sum of non-recurring expenditure of Rs.2,30,00,000/- (Rupees Two Crore and Thirty Lakh Only) towards the Strengthening of Trauma and Emergency Care in Government Hospital, Harur, Dharmapuri District.
- (ii) The Director of Medical and Rural Health Services is authorized to draw and deposit the amount sanctioned above into the Personal Deposit account of Tamil Nadu Medical Services Corporation towards to purchase Whole body Multi Slice CT-Scan and High End Image intensifier C-Arm with C-Arm compatible Orthopaedic Fracture Table with attachments Limited.
- (iii) A separate account to be maintained exclusively for Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program funds in the Directorate of Medical and Rural Health Services and facilities involved which should be operated by the joint signatory.

6. The expenditure sanctioned in para 5 (i) above shall be debited to the following head of account:-

2210 – Medical and Public Health – 01 Urban Health Services - Allopathy – 110 Hospitals and Dispensaries – Externally Aided Project – PD – Tamil Nadu Health System Reforms Project – Administrated by the Director of Medical and Rural Health Services – 319 Machinery and Equipments - 01 Purchase

(DPC 2210 - 01 -110 - PD - 31901)

7. Necessary additional funds of Rs.2,30,00,000/- will be provided in RE/FMA 2022–2023, pending provision of such funds in RE/FMA 2022–2023, the Director of Medical and Rural Health Services is authorized to draw and disburse the above sanctioned amount. However, this expenditure shall be brought to the notice of the Legislature by Specific Inclusion in the Supplementary Estimates 2022-2023. The Director of Medical and Rural Health Services is also requested to include this expenditure while sending the budget proposals for RE/FMA 2022-2023 and also send necessary draft explanatory notes for inclusion of this expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates 2022-2023 to Government in Finance (Health-II/Budget-I) Department at an appropriate time without fail.
