ORDER:

In the letter read above, the Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program has stated that Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program is supported by the World Bank aims at improving the quality of care in primary, secondary, and tertiary care facilities and proposed to take up the two Government Medical College Hospitals located in Tiruvallur and Omandurar Government Estate, B Block, Chennai are to be obtained Entry Level National Accreditation Board for Hospitals Accreditation in the year 2023-2024. The National Accreditation Board for Hospitals Entry level Accreditation Standards, break up details of the average cost arrived as per the Gap analysis of the concerned institution for NABH preparatory activities and the amount to be utilized to fulfill the NABH requirements are also furnished. The estimated budget for non-recurring cost to the activity is furnished as follows:-

2. The above proposal was approved by the State Health Assembly and the State Empowered Committee. Hence, the Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program has requested the Government to issue the orders in this regard.

3. The Government after careful consideration of the proposal of the Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program have decided to accept the same and accordingly issue the following orders:-

- i. Sanction is accorded for non-recurring expenditure of Rs.4,31,00,000/- (Rupees Four Crore and Thirty One Lakh only) towards NABH entry level certification for the Government Medical College Hospitals in Tiruvallur and Omandurar Government Estate, B Block for gap closure activities.
- ii. The Director of Medical Education and Research is authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned at para 3(i) above.
- iii. A separate account to be maintained exclusively for Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program funds in the Directorate and the Medical College involved which should be operated by joint signatory.
- iv. All expenditure from the allotted funds should be approved by the District Quality Committee.

4. The expenditure sanctioned in para 3 (i) above shall be debited to the following head of account:-

2210 – Medical and Public Health – 01 Urban Health Services - Allopathy – 110 Hospitals and Dispensaries – Externally Aided Project – PE – Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Project – Administrated by the Director of Medical Education – 309 Grants in Aid – 03 Grants for Specific Schemes
(DPC 2210 - 01-110 - PE-30903)

5. Necessary funds of Rs.4,31,00,000/- will be provided in Revised Estimate/ Final Modified Appropriation 2023–2024. Pending provision of such funds, the Director of Medical Education and Research is authorized to draw and disburse the above sanctioned amount. However, this expenditure shall be brought to the notice of the Legislature by Specific Inclusion in the Supplementary Estimates 2023-2024. The Director of Medical Education and Research is also requested to include this expenditure while sending the budget proposals for Revised Estimate / Final Modified Appropriation 2023 - 2024 and also send draft explanatory notes for inclusion of this expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates 2023-2024 to Government in Finance (BG-I/Health-II) Department at an appropriate time without fail.
